

What is a Wheel of the Year? It's something like a spiritual-religious calendar. It is rendered as a circle which identifies the Seasons, Festivals, and Thematic emphasis across Christian practice and many other world traditions. The Wheel is customized by each household - adding/removing elements to bring the calendar into deep relevance.
